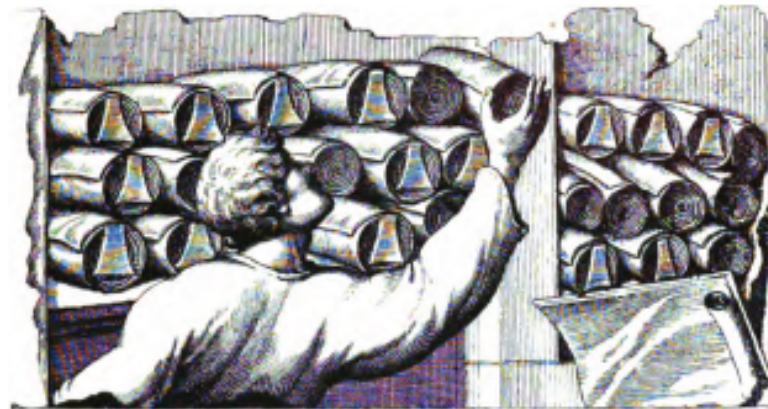


Fig. 21. A Roman taking down a roll from its place in a library.

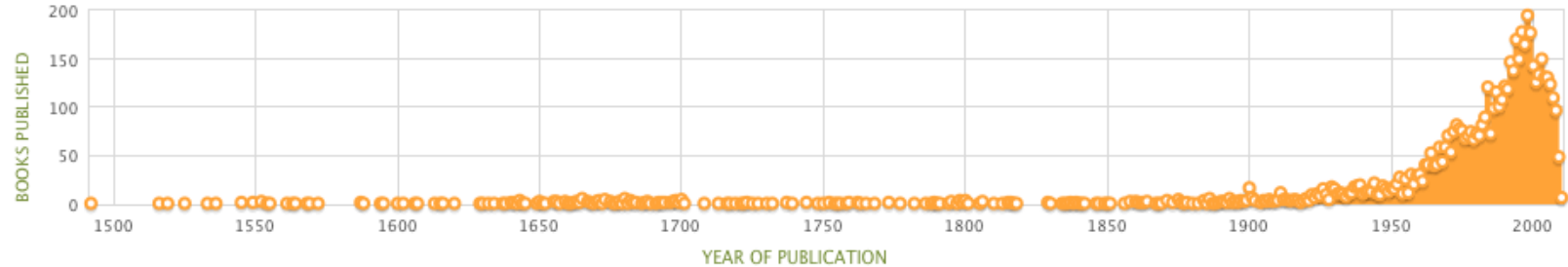
